Announcement of Available Temporary Land Use Permits for Rota West Harbor

The Commonwealth Port Authority (CPA) hereby announces that it is accepting applications for Temporary Land Use Permits for stevedoring services at the Rota West Harbor. Permits applications shall be accepted until August 5, 2024. For consideration, applications should include, but are not limited to, information pertaining to the applicant's possession of or plan to acquire:

- A Valid Business License for Stevedoring Services
- Public Liability and property damage insurance in the amount of \$500,000 for injury to or death of any one person, and in the sum of \$1,500,000 for injury to or death or more than one person, and in the sum of \$500,000 for damages to property and the Company shall name the Authority as an additional insurer, or an otherwise reasonable amount of insurance based on the nature of business
- Coast Guard Facility Security Officer (FSO) Requirements
- OSHA Certification
- Proposed Tariff Rates
- Operation Plan
- The Specific Area(s) of Rota West Harbor to be used

The maximum amount of time for which these permits shall be granted will be One Hundred Twenty (120) days.

The Authority shall impose a reasonable rate based on the nature of the land use.
