The Commonwealth Ports Authority (CPA) is soliciting statements of professional qualifications from interested Consultants for the Pagan Airstrip Airport Master Planning and Airports Geographic Information Systems (AGIS) Survey Services on the island of Pagan, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

These services are being funded by the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). Interested Consultants are requested to submit one (1) original, four (4) copies and one (1) electronic version in .pdf of their qualification statements by no later than <u>5:00 p.m. CHST, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2025.</u> It is recommended that qualification statements be presented by a combination of both brochures and the use of current U.S. Government Standard Form 330.

CPA reserves the right to reject any or all statements of professional qualification for any reason, if in its sole opinion to do so would be in its best interest.
